

Trick-or-Treat will be Saturday, Oct. 31 from 5 pm-7pm. The city's trick-or-treat will proceed as normal, but with the following guidelines:

- Turn on your front porch light if you would like to participate.
- Trick-or-treaters should always wear a face covering (except for those under 2) and stay 6' away from people not from your household when possible.
- Those passing out candy should always wear a face covering. Keeping as much distance as possible, the candy distributors should put the treats in the child's bag, rather than the children selecting their own treats. For small children, those accompanying them should consider holding their bag open.
- Carry hand sanitizer and use it often.
