AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FOUST CONSTRUCTION INC. FOR THE DOWNTOWN WATERLINE REPLACEMENT - PHASE III AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the city has identified the need to improve the delivery of water to the downtown section of the city through the Downtown Waterline Replacement Phase III; and,

WHEREAS, the project funding will be a combination of the Water Fund and an Ohio Public Works Commission interest free twenty (20) year loan; and,

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Council has advertised for bids in accordance with said authorization; and,

WHEREAS, on the 25th day of June 2015, bids were opened and Foust Construction Inc. was the lowest and best bidder in the amount of \$307,283.00 for the total base and alternate bid.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby authorize the Mayor of the City of Cortland to enter into a contract with Foust Construction Inc., 1700 Wilson Ave., Girard, OH 44420.

Section 2. The total cost of the project not to exceed \$307,283.00 will be paid from the following funds:

\$ 33,617.50	10-J-234	General Fund - Service Dept. Op - Professional Services
\$273,665.50	20-U-234	Issue II Fund - OPWC Loan

Section 3. This Ordinance having the procedural rules suspended shall take effect immediately as being in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Cortland, Ohio.
