AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO PURCHASE A 2016 CHEVY IMPALA FROM BYERS CHEVROLET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there is a need for the police department to purchase a new police cruiser; and,

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has reviewed and approved a quote from Byers Chevrolet for the 2016 Chevrolet Impala; and,

WHEREAS, the 2016 Chevrolet Impala is an eligible purchase through Ohio’s Cooperative Purchasing Program; and,

WHEREAS, the utilization and participation of the City of Cortland in Ohio’s Cooperative Purchasing Program allows the City of Cortland to purchase or lease new police vehicles for the best available price.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Cortland does hereby recognize the need for a new police cruiser.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby authorize the Chief of Police to purchase a 2016 Chevrolet Impala from Byers Chevrolet, 5887 N Meadows Dr, Grove City, OH 43123 through the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 3. The total cost not to exceed \$23,500.00 will be paid from Fund 35-J-251 – Police Levy Fund – General Operating – New Equipment.

Section 4. This Ordinance having the procedural rules suspended shall take effect immediately because the order cut-off date for the 2016 Chevrolet Impala is December 1, 2015.
