

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE PROJECT FUNDING FOR THE NORTH HIGH STREET PEDESTRIAN ENHANCEMENT PROJECT WITH GPD GROUP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Cortland, through R-10-14, supported the submission of an application to the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for funding assistance for the North High Street Pedestrian Enhancement Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Cortland, through O-73-14, authorized the Mayor to enter into an LPA agreement with ODOT to establish responsibilities for the administration of the project; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland has received funding for the North High Street Pedestrian Enhancement Project whereby TAP provides up to 80% of the construction and inspection costs with the City providing a minimum 20% contribution; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Cortland, through O-16-15, authorized the Mayor to enter an agreement with GPD Group for construction administration, inspection and material testing; and,

WHEREAS, there is a need to extend funding for services performed during construction administration, inspection and material testing of the sidewalk enhancement; and,

WHEREAS, GPD Group has submitted a contract modification for project administration fees at an additional cost not to exceed \$2,977.70.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Cortland City Council authorizes additional payment to GPD Group, 520 South Main St, Suite 2531, Akron, OH 44311 for construction administration and inspection of the North High Street Pedestrian Enhancement Project – PID 98871.

Section 2. That Council hereby authorizes payment for these additional fees described herein at a total cost not to exceed \$595.54 to be paid from Fund 10-J-234 – General – Service Dept. Operating – Professional Services.

Section 3. This Ordinance having the procedural rules suspended shall take effect immediately as being in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Cortland, Ohio.
