AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AND FOR THE CITY TO FUND A MUTUAL AGREEMENT FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE BETWEEN THE CITY OF CORTLAND AND TRUMBULL SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA mandated that small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems submit an NPDES storm water Phase II permit application by March 10, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland passed resolution R-03-03 supporting the efforts of Trumbull County in creating a regional storm water management plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland is currently a member of a regional Phase II Storm Water Management Plan Regulations within Trumbull County whose responsibility for implementation rests with the Trumbull Soil and Water Conservation District; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio EPA has commented on the Trumbull County Storm Water Management Plan and requires written memorandum of understanding when a particular entity has shared responsibility for implementing an aspect of the program; and

WHEREAS, the Trumbull Soil and Water Conversation District is responsible for implementation of portions of the Storm Water Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Trumbull Soil and Water Conversation District has the education, certification, expertise and experience for implementing aspects of the Storm Water Management Plan and will serve as an agent of the City; and

WHEREAS, there is an annual contribution for the Soil and Water Conservation Appropriation based upon a per resident cost (currently \$.35 per city resident) and a permit renewal fee for the City's share of the Ohio EPA permit; and

WHEREAS, the Mutual Agreement for Technical Assistance satisfies the permit requirements, is necessary to update the Storm Water Management Plan and is in the best interest of the City of Cortland.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Cortland authorizes the Mayor to sign the Mutual Agreement for Technical Assistance Between The City of Cortland and Trumbull Soil And Water Conservation District.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Cortland authorizes an expenditure not to exceed \$3,000 as the City's annual contribution for the Soil and Water Conservation Appropriation which shall be paid out of Fund 10-M-239 General – Storm Sewers – Misc. Contr.

Section 3. That the Council of the City of Cortland authorizes, when invoiced by the Trumbull County Commissioner's Office, the payment by the City of this program's Permit Renewal Fee which shall be included in the monthly bills for Council approval upon receipt by the City.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force as allowed by law.
