

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FIRE CHIEF TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL A POWER LIFT COT AND LOAD SYSTEM FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the fire department to purchase a new power lift cot and load system to reduce employee injuries; and,

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has reviewed and approved three (3) quotes to purchase and install a power lift cot and load system into the City Fire Department’s 2010 Ambulance not to exceed \$44,110.92; and,

WHEREAS, the Fire Department received a Capital Improvement Grant from The Ohio Bureau of Workers’ Compensation in the amount of \$33,083.19 to be used toward this purchase with the balance of \$11,027.73 to be paid by the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Fire Department also obtained an Ohio EMS Training and Equipment Grant in the amount of \$3,500 which will be used to offset the City’s portion of the purchase through a reimbursement to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby recognize the need for a power lift cot and load system to be installed into the Fire Department’s 2010 Ambulance.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby authorizes the Fire Chief to purchase and install a power cot and load system from the following vendors:

Myers Equipment Corp. 8860 Akron-Canfield Rd Canfield, OH 44406	<u>Install Power Load System</u> Total \$2,030.00

Section 3. The total cost not to exceed \$44,110.92.

Section 4. That the sum of \$33,083.19 was paid to the City through a Capital Improvement Grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers’ Compensation, the balance of \$11,027.73 will be paid from City Fund No. 95-M-251 (Fire Levy Fund – Operating Costs – New Equipment)

Section 5. That the sum of \$3,500 will be paid to the City through an Ohio EMS Training and Equipment Grant which will serve as a reimbursement to the Fire Levy Fund.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force as early as allowed by law.
