

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE O-09-14 THE CITY'S WATER TAP FEES AND SETTING FORTH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR WATER SERVICE CONNECTIONS

WHEREAS, there is a need to raise the water tap fees for new users of the City of Cortland Water System; and,

WHEREAS, this Ordinance will amend Ordinance O-09-14 and Codified Ordinance Section 921.05 so as to clearly establish rules and regulations for service connections for the City of Cortland's water service.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. A water service connection to the City of Cortland water system will only be available to parcels located in the municipal boundary or parcels subject to a service area agreement.

Section 2. A service connection will be provided when water is available and a water tap permit is obtained.

Section 3. Any waterline reimbursement fee (if applicable) must be paid, or subject to a payment plan approved by the Law Director, prior to the issuance of a water tap permit

Section 4. The water tap permit fee for customary single shut-off, single meter shall be as follows:

<u>Size of Tap (inches)</u>	<u>Tap Fee</u>
3/4"	\$1,450.00
1"	\$1,675.00
1 1/2"	\$2,250.00
2"	\$2,850.00

Section 5. At any time the majority of the land, buildings or structures or any of them belonging to any consumer of water being furnished by the City lie outside of the corporation limits of the City, the charge for the water line tap-in shall be two hundred percent (200%) of the rates set forth in Section 4 or as calculated in Section 6.

Section 6. The cost of all other non-standard service connections shall be based on labor, equipment and materials as calculated by the Service Director.

Section 7. Any new structure that utilized an existing water service connection will be charged for a new meter installation as calculated by the Service Director.

Section 8. This ordinance shall serve to repeal all prior ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof that address the City of Cortland's water service connection fees.

Section 9. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force as early as allowed by law.
