AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF TO PURCHASE FLOOR TILE FOR THE CORTLAND CITY POLICE STATION

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Cortland, through the passage of Ordinance O-28-16, approved the interior remodeling/renovations at the Cortland City Police Station; and,

WHEREAS, it is now necessary for the police department to purchase new floor tile; and,

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has researched product lines and received quotations; and,

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has reviewed and approved a quote from Carter Lumber to purchase floor tile for the police station not to exceed \$4,200.00.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby recognize the need to purchase floor tile at the Cortland City Police Station.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby authorize the Police Chief to purchase floor tile from Carter Lumber, 2167 Elm Rd, Cortland, OH 44410.

Section 3. The total cost not to exceed \$4,200.00 will be paid out of Fund 35-L-252 – Police - Buildings & Grounds - Building Improvements.

Section 4. This Ordinance having the procedural rules suspended shall take effect immediately as being in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Cortland, Ohio.
