AN ORDINANCE REPEALING O-31-16 AND WITHDRAWING FUNDING TO YNG AIR PARTNERS FOR DAILY FLIGHTS IN AND OUT OF THE YOUNGSTOWN-WARREN REGIONAL AIRPORT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2014, the City of Cortland passed Resolution R-21-14 pledging support to YNG Air Partners in its efforts to secure daily flights in and out of the Youngstown-Warren Regional Airport; and

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2016, the City of Cortland passed Ordinance O-31-16 funding its support for daily flights on a commercial air carrier that were ongoing in and out of the Youngstown-Warren Regional Airport; and

WHEREAS, Cortland has learned that those daily flights have been discontinued.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Cortland cancels its one-time payment in the amount of \$5,500.00 as the City’s local contributions to YNG Air Partners in support of daily flights in and out of the Youngstown-Warren Regional Airport.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Cortland repeals Ordinance O-31-16 in its entirety.

Section 3. This Ordinance having the procedural rules suspended shall take effect immediately in the best interest of the welfare of the residents of the City of Cortland, Ohio by saving the City from spending \$5,500.00 in support of a failed venture.
