AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO PURCHASE A NEW 2017 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR SPORT UTILITY VEHICLE FROM STATEWIDE FORD LINCOLN MERCURY

WHEREAS, there is a need for the Police Department to purchase a new police vehicle; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Police Chief has researched product lines and approved a quote from Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury for the 2017 Ford Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicle; and,

**WHEREAS**, the 2017 Ford Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicle is an eligible purchase through Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program which allows for, but does not require the use by the City of Cortland to purchase or lease new police vehicles at the best available price; and,

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to the authority in Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04(C), the vehicle will be purchased from Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury and will not be purchased through Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program due to the existence of a lower price, and equivalent terms, conditions and specifications from Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury.

## **NOW, THEREFORE:**

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Council of the City of Cortland does hereby recognize the need for a new police vehicle.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby authorize the Chef of Police to purchase a 2017 Ford Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicle from Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury, 1108 W. Main St., Van Wert, OH 45891.

<u>Section 3.</u> The total cost not to exceed \$26,855.00 will be paid from Fund 35-J-251 – Police Levy Fund – General Operating – New Equipment.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force as early as allowed by law.
