

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE STATE OF OHIO HOUSING REVOLVING LOAN FUND ADMINISTRATION AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland has been administering an Ohio State Administered Community Development Block Grant; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Community Services Division Office of Community Development has requested that City's, such as Cortland, enter into 3-year agreements enabling the City's participation in the state program; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of the 3-year agreement is to maintain adequate program oversight and to insure communities adhere to the program's rules and regulations; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Cortland believes it is in the best interest of its residents to participate in this program, as well as the CHIP Program (Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program).

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1: That the City of Cortland does hereby elect to continue to participate in the CDBG Program and the CHIP Program and agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Housing Revolving Loan Fund Administration Agreement.

Section 2: That the Mayor of the City of Cortland is authorized to sign the Housing Revolving Loan Fund Administration Agreement and submit it to the State.

Section 3: This Resolution is hereby authorized and shall take effect as early as allowed by law.
