

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ODOT TO PERFORM PID NO. 103274 TO REPLACE/UPGRADE SIGNS ON SECTIONS OF ST RT 46 AND ST RT 305 WITHIN THE CORPORATION LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO

WHEREAS, the State has identified the need for the described project:

Replace/upgrade signs on SR 46 from South Corp Limit (12.64) to SR 5 (13.39) and SR 305 from West Corp Limit (15.34) to East Corp Limit (15.57) in the City of Cortland

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Cortland in Trumbull County, Ohio, agrees that there is the need for the described project and is hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency, (LPA) for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND:

Section 1. Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

Section 2. Cooperation Statement

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the costs of the improvement.

The LPA further agrees to pay, if deemed necessary by the City at a later date, One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

Section 3. Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

Section 4. Maintenance

Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

Section 5.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force as early as allowed by law.
