

**A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING TRUMBULL COUNTY RECORDER DIANA MARCHESE ON HER RETIREMENT**

**WHEREAS**, it is with great pleasure that the City of Cortland joins others in honoring Mrs. Diana Marchese upon her retirement as Trumbull County Recorder; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Marchese was elected as the Trumbull County Recorder in 1992 and has continued holding office to date; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Marchese was born and raised in Warren, Ohio, daughter of Louis and Angeline Cappella, a Warren G. Harding High School Graduate, married to Dominic Marchese in 1963 they now have 4 children and 10 grandchildren; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Marchese moved to Johnston Township in 1973 where she was elected as clerk and served 9 years. Active in the farm community, Diana and Dominic began farming in 1974, choosing to name their farm Manna Farms which means “provided for by God daily. They began dairy farming in 1976, milking cows twice a day for 18 years and maintain a 248 acre farm; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Marchese is responsible for the operation of the Trumbull County Recorder’s Office; classified as a department of county government functioning for the protection of persons and property; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Marchese, as an elected official, is charged by law with the exacting duty of keeping certain specific records which may include: deeds, mortgages, financing statements, easements, leases, federal tax liens, military discharges, power of attorney, mechanics liens, plats, recognizance liens, partnerships, living wills, zoning resolutions, etc.; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Marchese led the initiative to have a new computer system installed in 2000 Document Technology Systems (DTS), escrow accounts were made available to the public and in 2001 the Recorder’s website went live; the first in the State of Ohio to go on-line with document images; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mrs. Marchese appointed the first county Archivist and created a Record Center, she received the Society of Ohio Archivists Merit Award. In 2014, Mrs. Marchese offered a service to provide free Military Picture I.D. Cards for Veterans.
