

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO PURCHASE THREE (3) NEW 2019 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR SPORT UTILITY VEHICLES AND PURCHASE AND INSTALL ACCESSORIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there is a need for the Police Department to purchase three (3) new police vehicles, to purchase the necessary equipment and accessories for each vehicle and to pay for the installation of the those accessories; and,

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has researched product lines and approved a quote from Statewide Ford & Emergency Products, LLC for the 2019 Ford Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has also researched product lines and approved quotes from the vendors listed below for the purchase and installation of necessary accessories in the three (3) new police cruisers; and,

WHEREAS, the 2019 Ford Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicle is an eligible purchase through Ohio’s Cooperative Purchasing Program which allows for, but does not require, the City of Cortland to purchase or lease new police vehicles through the State program; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority in Ohio Revised Code Section 125.04(C), the vehicles will be purchased from Statewide Ford & Emergency Products, LLC and will not be purchased through Ohio’s Cooperative Purchasing Program due to the existence of a lower price, and equivalent terms, conditions and specifications from Statewide Ford & Emergency Products, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. The Council of the City of Cortland does hereby recognize the need for its Police Department to acquire three (3) new police vehicles and the need for the purchase and installation of necessary accessory equipment for each vehicle.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby authorize the Chef of Police to purchase three (3) 2019 Ford Police Interceptor Sport Utility Vehicles and to purchase and have installed the necessary police equipment and accessories from the following vendors:
