

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FIRE CHIEF TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL A POWER LIFT COT FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FROM SOUTHEASTERN EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Fire Department to purchase a new power lift cot to reduce employee injuries; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has reviewed and approved three (3) quotes to purchase and install a power lift cot into the City Fire Department’s 2019 Ambulance not to exceed \$23,567.43; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department received a Capital Improvement Grant from The Ohio Bureau of Workers’ Compensation in the amount of \$6,916.81 to be used toward this purchase; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department also obtained an Ohio EMS Training and Equipment Grant in the amount of \$4,005.00 which will be used to reimburse the City’s portion of the purchase; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department solicited donations from local businesses and organizations and received a total of \$2,990.00 in donations from Cortland Lions Club (\$750), Cafaro Foundation (\$500), Cortland Rotary (\$250), Optimist Bazetta-Cortland (\$500), and Cortland Moose (\$390) towards the power cot purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby recognize the need for a power lift cot to be installed into the Fire Department’s 2019 Ambulance.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby authorize the Fire Chief to purchase and install a power cot from Southeastern Emergency Equipment, P.O. Box 1097, Youngsville, NC 27596.

Section 3. The total cost not to exceed \$23,567.43 will be paid from City Fund 2902-160-394 (Fire Levy, Emergency Medical Services, New Equipment).

Section 4. The sum of \$6,916.81 paid to the City through a Capital Improvement Grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers’ Compensation and the sum of \$4,005.00 paid to the City through an Ohio EMS Training and Equipment Grant will all be reimbursed to the City and deposited in the City Fund 2902-490-0000 (Fire Levy, Intergovernmental Grants) to be used towards this purchase.

Section 5. The sum of \$2,990.00 donated to the City Fire Department from local businesses and organizations will be deposited in City Fund 2902-820-0000 (Fire Levy, Donations) to be used towards this purchase.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force as early as allowed by law
