

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND INDICATING THE SERVICES THE CITY OF CORTLAND WILL PROVIDE TO THE OWNER OF REAL ESTATE CONTAINING .8970 ACRES OF TERRITORY PROPOSED FOR ANNEXATION FROM BAZETTA TOWNSHIP TO THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland has received legal notice of a traditional annexation along with a "Notice of Petition For Annexation" filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Trumbull County, Ohio, on the 14th day of February, 2018, which petition was signed by Diane K. Ashdown (along with her agent Attorney Thomas C. Nader) as owner of 3413 Niles Cortland Road in Bazetta Township, and further praying that the property described therein be annexed to the City of Cortland in the manner provided by law, a copy of said petition attached hereto and made a part hereof; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland is providing this Resolution timely pursuant to O.R.C. Section 709.03(D) more than 20 days prior to the annexation hearing before the Trumbull County Commissioners scheduled for April 25, 2018; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland makes available to its residents sewer and water services; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution R-49-80, passed September 22, 1980, property owners seeking annexation must be prepared to pay for extension of sewer and water lines and construction of streets to specification; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland welcomes this annexation in to the City of Cortland as an adjacent territory whose owner seeks annexation for the purpose of securing City services.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. The City of Cortland, Ohio will make its sewer and water services available to the owner of real estate residing in the territory which is the subject of a traditional annexation petition filed with the Board of County Commission of Trumbull County, Ohio on the 14th day of February, 2018, praying that said territory be annexed under Ohio Revised Code Section 709.02 in the manner provided by law, a copy of which notice is attached hereto and made a part of hereof.

Section 2. The owners of the real estate must be prepared to pay for the extension of these services to their territory.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force as early as allowed by law.
