A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A 911 MEMORIAL AS AN EAGLE SCOUT SERVICE PROJECT ON MUNICIPALLY OWNED PROPERTY IN FRONT OF CITY HALL

WHEREAS, Derek Sandor approached Mayor Woofter requesting to design and construct a 911 Memorial in front of City Hall honoring and remembering the 72 fallen police officers in the September 11, 2001 terror attacks; and,

WHEREAS, Derek is a freshman at Lakeview High School and a member of Boy Scout Troop 4050; and,

WHEREAS, the project is one of many requirements that will earn Derek an Eagle Scout rank; and,

WHEREAS, the design and construction of the 911 Memorial was discussed by the Cortland Parks and Recreation Board at its May 14, 2018 meeting and now recommends that Cortland City Council approve the project.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Cortland City Council does hereby approve the design and construction of a 911 Memorial as an Eagle Scout Service Project on municipally owned property in front of City Hall.

Section 2. This Resolution is hereby authorized and shall take effect as early as allowed by law.
