A RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PETITIONING THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, TRUMBULL COUNTY, OHIO FOR CONFORMITY OF THE BORDERS OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND AND BAZETTA TOWNSHIP WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Cortland passed legislation accepting the Annexation Petition submitted by Diane K. Ashdown under Resolution R-37-18 passed on September 4, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the limits of the City of Cortland now comprises territory of Bazetta Township, but not the whole of said township; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to have the boundaries of the City and Bazetta Township adjusted according to Ohio Revised Code Section 503.07.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Board of Commissioners of Trumbull County, Ohio, is hereby petitioned by this Council of the City of Cortland to change the lines of Bazetta Township and the corporation lines of the City of Cortland to make said township lines identical, in whole or in part, with the limits of this municipality resulting from annexation of 0.8970 acres (P.P.N. formerly known as 33-004500, 33-004501, 33-00502 and 33-004503) to the City of Cortland as shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A, according to the provisions of the Revised Code of Ohio.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify and authenticate a copy of this Resolution and petition and to cause the same to be served upon the Commissioners of Trumbull County, Ohio.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force as early as allowed by law.
