AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ODOT FOR THE RESURFACING OF SECTIONS OF STATE ROUTE 305, PID NO. 96568 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the following final legislation enacted by the City of Cortland, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Legislative Authority/Local Public Agency or “LPA”, in the matter of the stated described project; and

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of July, 2015, the LPA enacted legislation, Ordinance O-17-15, proposing cooperation with the Director of Transportation for the described project:

Resurfacing State Route 305 and State Route 305D between State Route 534 and State Route 7, lying within the City of Cortland; and

WHEREAS, the LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The City agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of the improvement within the city limits, less the amount of Federal-Aid funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation.

The share of the cost of the LPA is now estimated in the amount of Eighteen Thousand Four Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$18,412.00), but said estimated amount is to be adjusted in order that the LPA’s ultimate share of said improvement shall correspond with said percentages of actual costs when said actual costs are determined; and

WHEREAS, The Director of Transportation has approved said legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an estimate of cost and expense for improving the above described highway and has transmitted copies of same to this legislation authority; and

WHEREAS, the LPA desires the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the estimated sum, of Eighteen Thousand Four Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$18,412.00) is hereby appropriated for the improvement described above and the fiscal officer is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order on the treasurer for said sum upon the requisition of the Director of Transportation to pay the cost and expense of said improvement. We hereby agree to assume in the first instance, the share for the cost and expense over and above the amount to be paid from Federal funds.

Section 2. The total cost not to exceed \$18,412.00 will be paid from City Fund 2011-620-349 Street Construction Maintenance & Repair - Street Maintenance & Repair - Other Professional & Technical Services.

Section 3. That the LPA hereby requests the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

Section 4. That the LPA enter into a contract with the State and that Service Director be, and is hereby authorized to execute said contact, providing for the payment of the LPA the sum of money set forth herein above for improving the described project.

Section 5. That the LPA transmit to the Director of Transportation a fully executed copy of this Ordinance.

Section 6. That this Ordinance having the procedural rules suspended shall take effect immediately as being in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Cortland, Ohio.
