AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CORTLAND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RONYAK PAVING INC. FOR THE 2019 ASPHALT RESURFACING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland has identified the need to resurface certain streets for the 2019 Asphalt Resurfacing Program and include the following roadways:

Base Bid - OPWC Funds
S Colonial Dr
Arbor St
Rosewae Ave
Woodview Dr (Russell Ave to Cricket Ln)

Alternate Bid "A" - Additional Streets with Local Funds
Lakeview Dr (Greenbriar Dr to Wae Tr)
Beechwood Dr (Southdale Blvd to Spring Creek Dr)

Alternate Bid "B" – Additional Street with Local Funds
Cricket Ln

WHEREAS, the City applied to participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) State Capital Improvement and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program and has obtained an OPWC grant to pay 39% of the project cost up to \$75,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Council has advertised for bids in accordance with said authorization; and

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of May, 2019, bids were publicly opened and Ronyak Paving Inc. was the lowest and best bidder of combined bid items in the amount of \$310,090.65.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby authorize the Mayor of the City of Cortland, Ohio to enter into a contract with Ronyak Paving Inc., 14736 N Cheshire St, Burton, OH 44021 for the 2019 Asphalt Resurfacing Program.

Section 2. The local share of the project is \$235,090.65 which will come out of the following City Funds:

\$110,090.65 2011-620-349 Street Construc. Maint. & Repair - Professional/Technical Services
\$125,000.00 2101-620-340 Permissive Motor Vehicle Tax – Professional/Technical Services

Section 3. The Finance Director of the City of Cortland shall be authorized to make payment to Ronyak Paving, Inc. upon completion of said project and upon having approval of the Service Director that said work is done according to specifications as set forth by the City of Cortland.

Section 4. This Ordinance having the procedural rules suspended shall take effect immediately as being necessary to expedite the roadway project and protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Cortland, Ohio.
