**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE O-31-15
ESTABLISHING THE TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR THE
PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND**

WHEREAS, there is a need to adjust the rate and establish the terms of employment for the part-time police officers of the City of Cortland, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby recognize that this ordinance will allow the Police Department to attract the area’s best candidates and is therefore in the best interest of the safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Cortland.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby set the wage of \$10.00 per hour for part-time police officers hired after July 16, 2019 in the Field Training Program of the City of Cortland Police Department.

Section 2. Upon completion of the Field Training Program, as determined by the Chief of Police, the wage will increase to \$14.00 per hour for the part-time police officers.

Section 3. Part-time police officers not in the Field Training Program shall be paid an amount double the rate schedule for work performed on holidays set forth in the current Northern Ohio Patrolmen’s Benevolent Association contract with the City of Cortland.

Section 4. Part-time officers shall receive an annual uniform equipment allowance in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150). This amount shall be paid with the first payday of July.

Section 5. Part-time officers, in an off-duty status, who must appear in criminal or civil court or meet with any prosecutor or any official as part of their official duty as a law enforcement officer with the City of Cortland, shall receive a minimum of three (3) hours of regular pay.

Section 6. Part-time officers, who are working a detail or event that is solely paid for by funds from a grant or allowance using State of Ohio or Federal Government funds, will be paid at a flat rate of \$25.00 per hour.

Section 7. All ordinances and parts of ordinances contrary to the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force as early as allowed by law.
