

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN LPA FEDERAL LOCAL-LET PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ESTABLISH THE RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE MECCA STREET RESURFACING & INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PID 104626

WHEREAS, the resurfacing of Mecca Street from Wakefield Drive through the SR5/SR46 overlap and continuing onto SR46 to the Cortland North Corporation line, with work one signal, is a transportation activity eligible to receive Federal funding; and

WHEREAS, on September 19, 2016, Cortland City Council approved R-32-16, supporting the application for Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP); and

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland has received funding approval for the Mecca Street Resurfacing & Intersection Improvement Project from Eastgate Regional Council of Governments; and

WHEREAS, it is the mutual desire of both ODOT and the City of Cortland to have the City of Cortland serve as the responsible lead agency for the administration of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Cortland does hereby authorize the Mayor of the City of Cortland to enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio to establish the responsibilities for the administration of the Mecca Street Resurfacing & Intersection Improvement Project.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
