AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER AN AGREEMENT WITH GPD GROUP TO PERFORM ENGINEERING AND DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE MECCA STREET RESURFACING & INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, PID 104626

WHEREAS, Resolution R-32-16, passed on September 19, 2016, authorized the application for Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) Funds programmed by the Eastgate Regional Council of Government to improve the Mecca Street Resurfacing & Intersection Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland received funding approval for the Mecca Street Resurfacing & Intersection Improvement Project from Eastgate Regional Council of Governments whereby eligible activities will be funded at 80% with the City being responsible for the remaining 20%; and

WHEREAS, upon the passage of Ordinance O-36-19, the City will enter a LPA Federal Local-Let Project Agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation to administer the project; and

WHEREAS, the City requested and received Letters of Interest from four (4) design engineering firms; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cortland selected GPD Group as the qualified firm with knowledge of previous projects and was requested to provide a cost proposal for the services; and

WHEREAS, the consultant has provided a detailed technical and cost proposal for the design services; and

WHEREAS, the cost of authorized services is not to exceed \$109,206.00 with the City being responsible for \$21,841.20 which may be reimbursable by OPWC.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Cortland City Council authorizes the Mayor to enter an agreement with GPD Group, 520 South Main St, Suite 2531, Akron, OH 44311 to perform engineering and design services for the Main Street Resurfacing & Intersection Improvement Project.

Section 2. That Council hereby authorizes payment for services at a cost not to exceed \$21,841.20 to be paid from City Fund 2011-620-349 (Street Maintenance & Repair, Professional & Technical Services).

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force as early as allowed by law.
